



Review of GM Risk Assessments

GM risk assessments and controls must be reviewed regularly and at least annually.

GM risk assessments must also be reviewed immediately if there has been a change to the scope or risks of the work.

GM risk assessments must be reviewed if there has been an incident, accident or near miss in connection to the work covered by the risk assessment.

When reviewing the risk assessment the effectiveness of the preventative or control measures should be carefully re-examined.

If review of the risk assessment concludes that changes are required then those changes must be made while following the correct process including where required review and approval by the School GMBSC.

Review of risk assessments must be recorded by signing and adding the date of the latest version in Section 8 at the end of the GM risk assessment form. The risk assessment should be signed and dated whether or not there have been changes made to the risk assessment in order to demonstrate the review has occurred.

(Note: If you are using a School's local version of the GM risk assessment form then you should add the signature and review date in the relevant review section of the form).
