

## Fire Awareness Training

The Fire Awareness Training course is a "Self-Enrol" course.

To find the course, log into Learn (<u>www.learn.ed.ac.uk</u>) with your EASE details. If you have not previously enrolled in the course and it is not showing in your list of "My Courses", please click on the "Self-Enrol" tab in the top right hand corner.



You may now use the "Search Catalogue" search bar (using "fire awareness" as key words and with "Search Entire Catalogue" selected) or click on the "Self Enrol Health & Safety Courses" in the Course Catalogue (self-enrol courses) section.



Find the course you wish to enrol on in this list and click on the arrow to the right hand side of the "Course ID" (zu\_Fire\_Awareness\_Training) and click on "Enrol". Click "Submit" on the next screen, then OK on the following screen. The course should now open.

The quiz contains eight multiple choice questions, based on the information provided in the course. When ready to take the test, please click on "Quiz" at the bottom of the screen. The test will not start until you click "Begin" on the following screen. The test is not timed and you can take it as many times as you wish. You must score at least 80% to pass the course. On completion of the quiz, the following box will appear:
