- Make it clear what is Policy, what is supporting Framework, what are Codes of Practice and what is guidance
- Continue with golden copy on the H&S www site, but
- Make the www documents easier to access, navigate and cross-reference


New H&S Policy structure and format

- Policy Booklet (www and printed)
- Framework Part One: Organisation
- Framework Part Two: Arrangements
 - Codes of Practice
 - Guidance documents
 - Golden copy on the H&S www site

Informatics Forum

The New Policy Booklet

- The only printed part of the new structure
- Content updated, but not hugely different



- Designed for use within the UoE and for external recipients
- Changes over time should be minimal, and readily accommodated

The Supporting Framework

- Split into Organisation and Arrangements sections
- Contain updated versions of:
 - ☐ the old Part One
 - ☐ some of the old Part Two
 - ☐ legal/arrangements sections of Parts 3-8
- Signpost to Codes of Practice and Guidance

Codes of Practice & Guidance

- Codes of Practice
 - currently Radiation Protection / Chemical Safety
 - CoPs will be used sparingly
- Guidance documents
 - ☐ currently relatively unstructured mass of information
 - grown organically by each Unit of H&SD
- Group exercise
 - ☐ what do you want from this tier of guidance?
 - ☐ how would you like to see h&s guidance structured?
 - ☐ how would you like to access this guidance?
